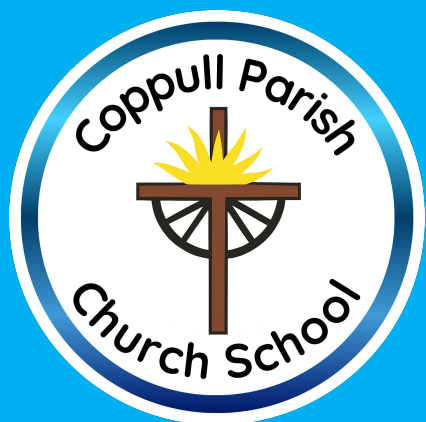


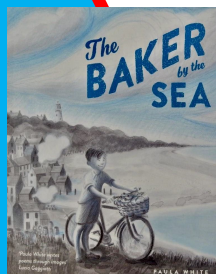


Year 4



Maths

This half term, the children will focus on Place Value: partitioning, rounding, mental addition and subtraction of 4 digit numbers. This will evolve into written skills when adding and subtracting 4 digits numbers, which are too complicated to do mentally.



English

During the first Autumn term, the children will read *The Baker by the Sea* and produce a brochure using topic based themes. In addition, the class will read 'The Matchbox Diary' and write their own biography, focussing on important events and achievements in an individual's life.

A Living World!

Science

This half term, Year 4 will be grouping and classifying living things. This will require the children to learn about the different types of vertebrates and invertebrates with their key features, along with flowering and non-flowering plants. With this information, children will learn to group living things with classification keys.

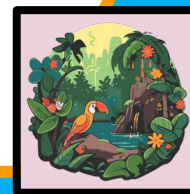
RE

Pupils will identify and explore the key values at the heart of different faiths. They will also recognise the similarities and differences between the key values of at least 3 World Faiths. Furthermore, pupils are to make the connection between sacred texts, values and behaviour. Finally, pupils will identify the values that the pupils consider to be particularly important.



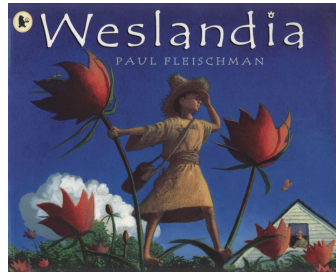
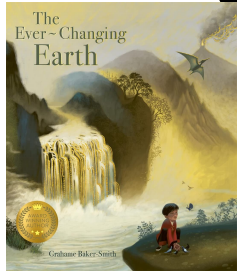
Geography

This half term, Year 4 will be identifying where in the world are rainforests? They will be researching what they are like, who lives there and how are they changing. Children will then be comparing this with our local woodland and conducting some data collection.

PE

This half term, pupils will improve upon their fundamental movement skills, focussing on running, jumping and throwing in isolation and combinations.

In the second PE session of the week, children will look at football skills. Using tactics for attacking, defending. The skills of dribbling and passing towards the goal will be key here.

Enrichment

Computing

Children will apply their knowledge and understanding of networks, to appreciate the internet as a network of networks which need to be kept secure.

They will learn that the World Wide Web is part of the internet, and will be given opportunities to explore the World Wide Web for themselves in order to learn about who owns content and what they can access, add, and create.

Art

This term, children are introduced to the genre of still life as an old art form and also one which is still enjoyed by many contemporary artists. Pupils revisit and develop their drawing (and looking) skills using observational drawing of physical objects, and then go on to working with watercolour.

PSHE

This half term, the children will be looking at difficult emotions like jealousy, understanding how they look physically and managing them in positive ways. The class will be looking at how difficult emotions are a part of life and how to communicate them through both words and body language.

Music

This half term, Year 4 will be learning the different parts of the ukulele and the 4 string names. Children will use these skills to help play chords, starting with the C chord and C7 chord. Using C chords will allow children to play melodies and simple songs.
