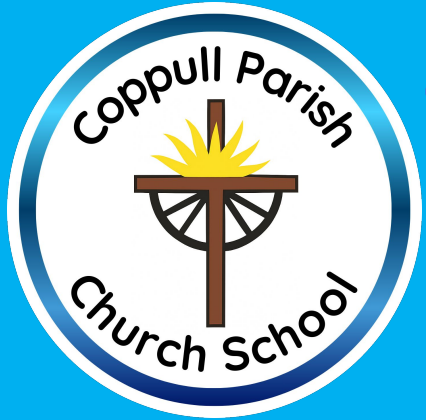
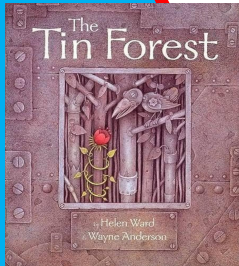
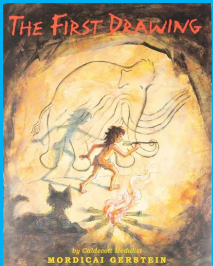




Year 3



Maths

We will be learning about place value up to 1000. Children will represent & partition numbers up to 1000 and practise estimating on a number line.

In addition & subtraction children will learn how to use the column addition and column subtraction method on 3 digit numbers.

Digging into the Past

Science

We will be exploring rocks, fossils and soils. Children will learn about different types of rocks, how fossils are formed and the importance of soil. They will carry out investigations, complete a local rock survey, and investigate which type of soil absorbs the most water, developing their scientific enquiry skills.



RE

Our R.E units for this half term are Harvest and Called by God. Children will learn about Harvest, thinking about giving thanks and helping others, and explore how different people respond to being called by God through key religious stories and beliefs.



History

We will be exploring the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age, considering which period we would prefer to have lived in. Children will learn how life changed over time and use artefacts and timelines to make simple historical deductions using evidence.

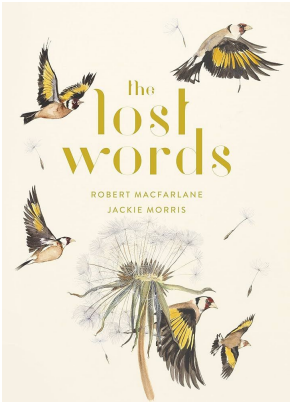

PE

We will be developing fundamental movement skills, including running, jumping, balancing, throwing and catching. Children will apply these skills in games such as handball and take part in swimming lessons over two weeks to build confidence, coordination and control.



Enrichment

Our enrichment this half term includes daily swimming, Stone Age cave painting in a classroom cave, and a local walk to complete a rock survey.

Computing

We will be learning about computing systems and networks – connecting computers, and managing online information. Children will understand how computers connect and share information, and how to stay safe online by protecting privacy, security and ownership while developing responsible use of technology.

Art

We will be learning about gestural drawing using charcoal. Children will explore mark making and sketching techniques, and create Stone Age-inspired drawings using charcoal to develop their artistic skills and expression.



Music

We will be learning to find and keep a steady beat, develop rhythm through singing and performing, and explore notation skills using Charanga. Children will build listening skills, confidence and musical understanding while exploring the question, "How does music bring us closer together?"

PSHE

Our PSHE units are Feelings & Emotions, including jealousy and how to manage it, and A World Without Judgement. Children will explore grief, tolerance and democracy, learning how to create a fair and respectful world while developing empathy, confidence and respect for others.
