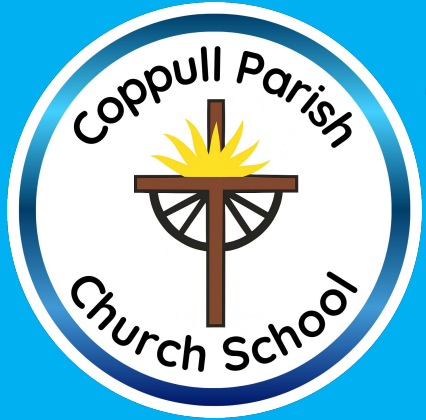




Year 2

We will be learning about place value up to 100. Children will represent & partition numbers up to 100 and practise estimating on a number line.

In addition & subtraction children will learn how to use the column addition and column subtraction method on 2 digit numbers.

Brave Bears Club



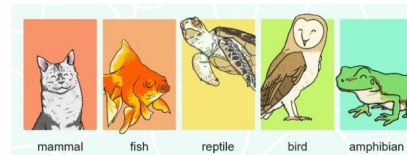
RE

Our R.E unit for this half term children will explore the following question: Why are sacred texts so important to people of faith?



Science

We will be exploring animals needs for survival (including humans). Children will learn about how the 5 different classification groups mammals, reptiles, amphibians, birds and fish. They will be able to identify the differences between animal groups and what requirements are needed in order for them to survive.



History

We will be exploring the question: How was school different in the past? We will be learning about schools in the 1900s and comparing them to schools now. We will also exploring what hasn't changed.

English

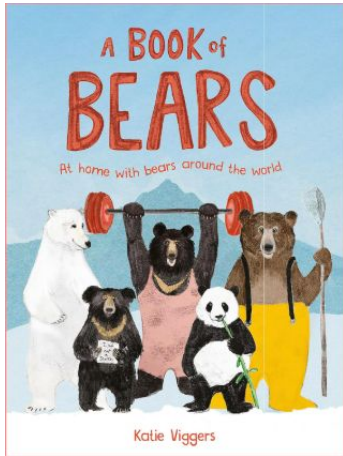
We will be exploring two exciting books: *The Bear & the Piano* and *The Bear Under the Stairs*. Children will write their own narrative version based on the theme of bravery, using expanded noun phrases for descriptive language. The Children will then explore fact and fiction around bears to create information reports to help our character from the book feel less scared.

PE

We will be developing fundamental movement skills, including running, jumping, balancing, throwing and catching. Children will also take part in daily swimming lessons during the first two weeks of term to build confidence, coordination and control.

Our enrichment this half term includes daily swimming and building a brave bear obstacle course.

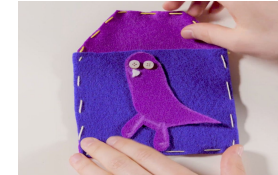
Computing

We will be learning about Computing Systems and Networks. The children will explore how IT is all around us.



DT

In DT (textiles) we will be making a material pouch. Children will learn to sew a running stitch with regular-sized stitches. Prepare and cut fabric to make a pouch from a template and use a running stitch to join the two pieces of fabric together.



Music

We will explore rhythm, timbre and improvisation through the songs "Hello" and "Hey Friends." We explore greetings and friendship through call-and-response activities, using tuned and untuned percussion to create simple question-and-answer rhythms. We also learn about timbre by listening to and identifying different instruments.
