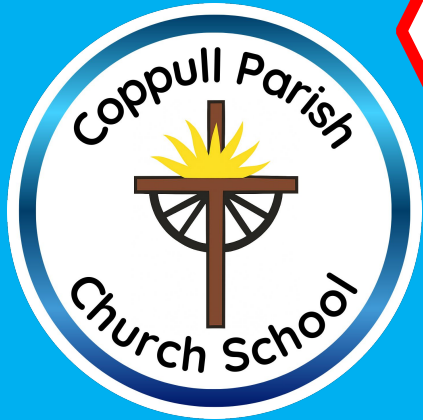
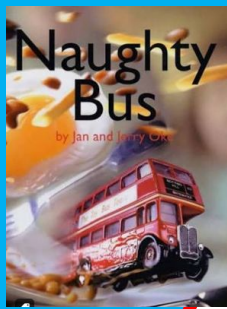
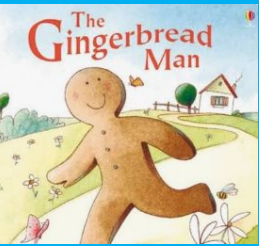
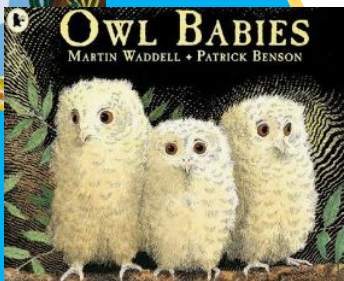




Reception



Literacy

We will develop early comprehension skills by listening to and talking about a wide range of stories, rhymes and non-fiction texts, focusing on the 4 key texts. We will learn to answer simple questions, retell key events, discuss characters and settings, and make predictions, helping them to develop a love of reading and an understanding of what they have heard. We will work on name writing and letter formation linked to our Daily Phonics sessions.

Why are we all different and special?
Why do Christians say thank you to God at Harvest time?

We will learn that every person is unique and valued, developing respect for ourselves and others. We will also discover why Christians give thanks to God for the harvest, exploring themes of gratitude, caring for others and sharing with those in need through stories, discussions and practical activities.

Maths

We will develop early mathematical understanding through the first 3 White Rose Maths units. We will learn to match, sort and compare objects, explore patterns, and use mathematical language to describe size, shape and measure. We will initially focus on recognising, counting and representing the numbers 1, 2 and 3, developing a secure understanding of quantity and number through practical, hands-on activities.

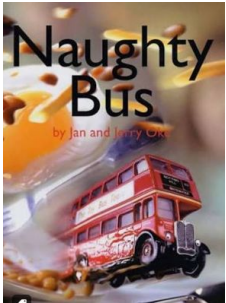

Understanding the World

Through the story of Naughty Bus we will learn about our school and our local area of Coppull, considering the buildings in our locality. We will then compare our local area with the city of London. We will also learn about jobs and 'People who help us' in our community and beyond.

When the Naughty Bus turns into a Night Bus we will learn about light and dark, and nocturnal animals! We will end the half term by learning all about the beautiful season of Autumn.

Speaking & Listening Opportunities

We will launch our rota for Weekly Show and Tell sessions.

We will listen to each child's presentation about a Parent's Job during our 'People who help us' week.

We will begin to prepare our own snack, and eat it whilst promoting conversation around a 'dinner table' setting.



Expressive Arts and Design

We will design, make and decorate Gingerbread Men. We will learn about creating structures, by making our own Coppull building- including developing our cutting and joining skills. We will look at the artwork of Andy Goldsworthy and create our own Autumn transient artwork.



PE

We will introduce visiting the hall for PE and will work on getting changed for this session. We will develop fundamental movement skills, including balancing, running, jumping, hopping and travelling safely in different ways. We will learn how to work independently and with others, follow simple instructions and rules, and begin to develop confidence, coordination and enjoyment of being active through a range of fun, engaging games.

PSED - 1 Decision

The EYFS 1decision programme uses colourful characters and engaging stories to help children explore emotions, relationships, safety and healthy choices. Through discussions, role play and practical activities, we help the children to develop the confidence and skills to make positive decisions in everyday situations.
